



Rocky Mountain Region Award for Volunteer Service to the American Chemical Society

Purpose: To recognize the volunteer efforts of individuals who have served the American Chemical Society, contributing significantly to the goals and objectives of the Society through their regional activities.

Nature and Establishment: The award consists of an ACS Salute to Excellence plaque to be presented at each regional meeting acknowledging the contributions of Society volunteers.

Rules of Eligibility: A nominee must be a member of the American Chemical Society residing in the Central Arizona, Central New Mexico, Central Utah, Colorado, Salt Lake, Southern Arizona, or Wyoming local sections, and will have made significant contributions to the Rocky Mountain Region of the American Chemical Society. Past and present members of the ACS Board of Directors and staff are ineligible for this award.

A nominee may stay in the pool for the RMR award for three years; however, updated nomination forms must be submitted in each of the two following years. Although a nominee remains in the pool, new nominations are encouraged each year.

Nomination Deadline: March 15, 2008
